What is Homeopathy?



Homeopathy, a system of natural medicine, was founded by Dr. Samuel Hahnemann, a German physician and chemist, over 200 years ago. The principles on which it is based have been utilized in healing for thousands of years.

Rather than focusing on one condition or symptom typical of a conventional medical assessment, Homeopathic treatment takes into consideration all the person's symptoms—physical, emotional and mental, before choosing an appropriate Homeopathic remedy. This is the hallmark of an holistic approach to healthcare.

Homeopathic pharmaceuticals or remedies, are prepared from various naturally occurring substances including plants, minerals and animals. These preparations are put through a process called “potentization” and are highly diluted and non-toxic. Despite extreme dilution, they are capable of activating the body's own powers of self-regulation and self-healing, without the potential side effects of conventional medicine.



Homeopathy is considered a form of alternative and complementary medicine that is holistic, scientifically based, safe to use, inexpensive and can treat acute illnesses as well as chronic disease. It is a complementary modality to other therapies such as herbal medicine, nutritional programs, acupuncture, and mind-body medicine. Homeopathy has been recognized for its success in treating epidemics including flu, malaria, cholera and typhoid.

Since its inception Homeopathy has benefitted people from all walks of life, of any age, and in countries all over the world.
